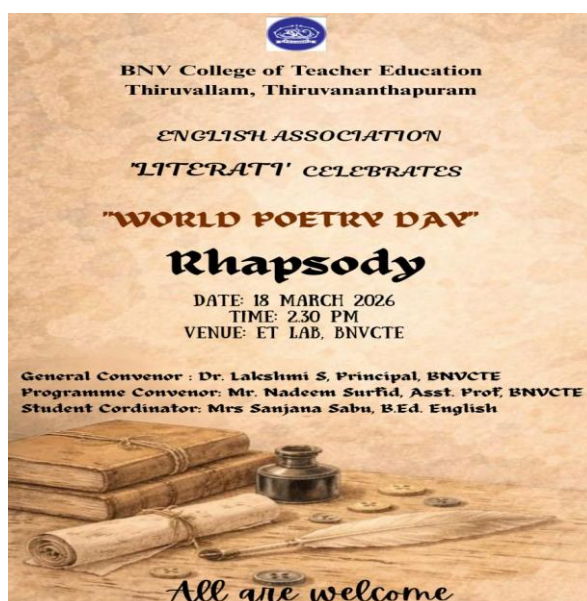


REPORT ON WORLD POETRY DAY LITERATI CELEBRATION – “RHAPSODY”
