Community Living Camp 2024





The Community Living Camp for the 2022-2025 batch of BNV College of Teacher Education took place from December 16 to December 20, 2024, at the Mitranikethan city center in Thiruvananthapuram. This event was titled 'AYKYA 24' and the Camp Officers was Mrs. Shiny Pratap and Mrs. Rekha L. R., with student coordinator Akshara G. The camp was officially inaugurated by Dr. Suni Kumari P.
