INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON TEACHER EDUCATION @ 2030

BNV College of Teacher Education, in collaboration with the Council for Teacher Education Foundation (CTEF) Kerala, hosted a two-day International Conference on "Teacher Education @ 2030: A Visionary Roadmap for Progressive Education" on September 6 & 7, 2024. The event brought together 129 delegates, including teacher educators, researchers, and students, to discuss the future of teacher education in alignment with NEP 2020. The conference was inaugurated by Dr. Raju Narayana Swamy IAS, Principal Secretary, Government of Kerala and featured keynote address from distinguished speakers such as Dr. Provita Rani Karmakar from Bangladesh.



The event also included a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signing between BNVCTE and CTEF, strengthening academic collaboration. The conference featured five insightful sessions, including discussions on NEP 2020, digital platforms, employability skills, and AI tools for education. Experts such as Dr. Brinda Bazeley, Dr. K.Y. Benedict, and Dr. Briju Thankachan led engaging presentations, while over 30 research papers were presented by scholars. The event concluded with a valedictory session, including a tribute to Late Thiruvallam N. Atchutan Nair, the founder of BNV Trust, and a special address by Smt. Easwari Amma, Chairperson of BNV Trust. The feedback from delegates highlighted the significance of the discussions in shaping future educational policies. The conference successfully provided a platform for academic discourse, innovation, and collaboration in teacher education, inspiring educators to implement progressive teaching methodologies.
