Fibonacci Day Celebration

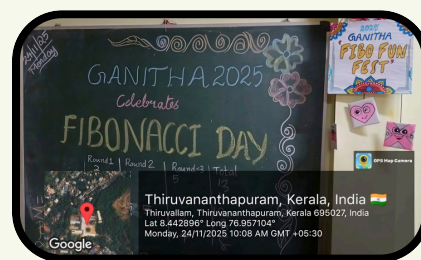

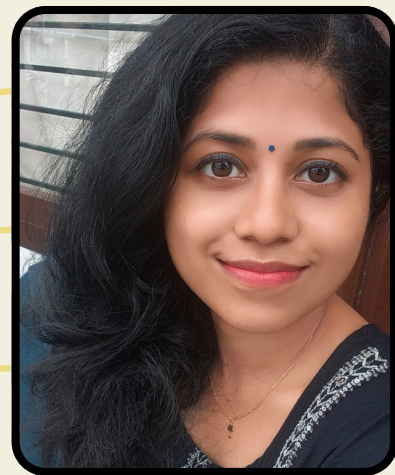
