
Blood Donation Camp

As part of the World Blood Donors Day, BNV College of Teacher Education conducted a Blood Donation Camp on 28th June 2024. It was a collaborative programme conducted by BNV College with the guidance of the faculty from PRS Hospital. A group of doctors and medical staff visited the college as part of the camp.



All the preparations and facilities required for the process of donating blood were duly completed by the students and faculty of the college. Certain classes were rearranged to be used as centers and beds were arranged for the donors. Proper facilities were also provided to accommodate the team from the hospital.



The programme started around 10 am. It was initiated by our principal Dr. Lakshmi Ma'am followed by an awareness talk given by the doctor. Soon after the donation process commenced. The donors were systematically called and given a miniature checkup before donating blood. A total of 31 people including the students and teachers of various departments took part in the process. The programme was concluded around 12.30 pm.
