INTER - COLLEGIATE RECITATION COMPETITION



BNV College of Teacher Education hosted Aalaap, a distinguished inter-collegiate recitation competition, to commemorate late Sri N Achuthan Nair, the founder and guiding force of the BNV group. The competition featured recitations in three languages: English, Hindi, and Malayalam. Winners received the Thiruvallam N Achuthan Nair memorial ever-rolling trophy, along with individual trophies and certificates for all participants

This year, Aalapp took place on June 10th 2025, featuring participation from students across various Arts and Science colleges, as well as Teacher Education institutions. A distinguished panel of judges evaluated recitations in Malayalam, English, and Hindi. The competition

commenced at 9:30 AM, with each participant allotted a time frame of ten minutes for their performance.

The Ever Rolling Trophy for the Malayalam recitation competition was awarded to Aleena S. Das from St. Thomas College Mukkolakkal, Rincy Roy Johnson from Christ College Vizhijam securing the second prize and Anurag M. C. from Mahatma Gandhi College, Kesavadasapuram, third prize. In the English recitation category, Adithya Lakshmi P. B. from Mar Theophilus Training College, Nalanchira, emerged as the winner of the Ever Rolling Trophy, while Aparna Elizabeth from the Government College of Teacher Education, Thycadu, claimed the second prize, and Glity Dais Alexy from Mar Theophilus Training College, Nalanchira, received the third prize. For the Hindi recitation competition, the Ever Rolling Trophy was awarded to Aparna A. I. from St. Thomas Training College, Mukkolakkal, with Glity Dais Alexy as the second prize winner and Aiswarya M. from PTM College of Education, Maruthoorkonam, finishing in third place.
