On Friday, 10 July 2026, participants from various colleges arrived at the campus in the morning. The registration process commenced as scheduled, where participants completed verification of their entries and received their identification details.



Following registration, student volunteers efficiently guided each contestant to their respective competition venues.

The competitions commenced promptly at 10.00 a.m., demonstrating the meticulous planning and punctuality of the organizing committee. To facilitate smooth conduct, the competitions were organized simultaneously in three separate venues:

- Malayalam Recitation Competition: Seminar Hall–I, Second Floor, Main Building
- English Recitation Competition: ET Lab, Cellar Floor, Main Building
- Hindi Recitation Competition: D.El.Ed Classroom, First Floor, D.El.Ed Wing

Each venue was well equipped with seating arrangements, sound systems, judging desks, participant waiting areas, and event volunteers.

A panel comprising three experienced judges was appointed for each language category. The judges included eminent academicians and language experts with extensive experience in literature and recitation.

Prior to the commencement of the programme, the judges were briefed regarding the evaluation procedures. Judging sheets were prepared well in advance,

ensuring fairness, transparency, and uniformity throughout the competition. Participants were evaluated on several parameters, including:

- Pronunciation and articulation
- Clarity of recitation
- Voice modulation
- Expression and emotional presentation
- Stage confidence
- Memorization
- Overall impact and presentation

The judging process was conducted with utmost impartiality and professionalism.

The event witnessed an overwhelming response from teacher education institutions across Thiruvananthapuram. The participation details are as follows:

- Malayalam Recitation: 19 participants
- English Recitation: 15 participants
- Hindi Recitation: 11 participants

In total, 45 students representing 14 colleges enthusiastically participated in the competition.

The impressive participation reflected the growing popularity and academic significance of ***Alaap*** as an intercollegiate literary event.
