BNV College of Teacher Education, Thiruvallam. Under the auspices of the Malayalam Association 'Prayaga', a program titled "Karkidakam and Rituals" (Karkidakamum Acharangalum) was organized. Mehraj, a student from the Malayalam department, spoke about the unique features of the month of Karkidakam, while Anjana spoke about 'Andaruthi' (the year-end cycle). Anjitha discussed the medical treatments during Karkidakam, and Arya spoke on the significance of 'Karkidaka Vavu' (the new moon day in Karkidakaam).

As children held both familiar and unfamiliar notions about Karkidakam, the students adopted a simple approach to broaden their knowledge. Through a video screening, they were able to easily introduce topics of Karkidakam's importance to the students. Following this introduction, a quiz competition was organized based on the knowledge shared by the speakers, and prizes were distributed to the winners. Under the leadership of Ashwin, a program called 'Kavile Pattu Malsaram' (Song Competition in the Sacred Grove) was conducted, which turned out to be the most attractive highlight. The main objective of this competition was to identify movie songs based on the Ramayana. The students were divided into four groups and named Mukkutti, Karuka, Thiruthali, and Nilappana (after the traditional medicinal herbs).

The principal, Dr. Lakshmi S. Teacher, served as the program convenor, while Feba Samuel Teacher, a professor in the Malayalam department, and Arya J.H. worked as organizers. "Karkidakam and Rituals" became a noteworthy event that fostered basic awareness among the children about the customs of the month of Karkidakam.

In the competition, the Karuka team secured the first place, the Thiruthali team won the second place, and the Nilappana and Mukkutti teams jointly shared the third place. The respected principal distributed prizes to the winners. The event concluded with a vote of thanks by the program coordinator, Arya.
