INTRODUCTION

A woman's voice represents her freedom to express her thoughts, opinions and experiences, while her rights ensure her dignity, equality, safety and protection.

Awareness of rights is an important step towards empowerment. Women who are informed about their rights are better equipped to identify discrimination, harassment and injustice and to seek appropriate assistance. The theme is particularly significant in teacher education, where future teachers can promote gender equality, mutual respect and awareness among children.
