Guidelines for paper presentations

- Abstract of the proposed paper should be sent on or before 16th Aug 2024, 12pm and the full paper should be sent via email on or before 23rd Aug 2024, 12pm.
- The abstract should not exceed 200 words and the full text paper (A4) should not exceed 3000 words.
- Mention the title, relevant subtheme, author/s and full official address with name of the institution.
- The full paper should have the abstract with keywords, main text and reference in APA 7th edition format with 1.5 line spacing and Times New Roman font (12 point). The paper should be submitted as MS word in .doc or .docx format.
- Papers should be original and should not have been published anywhere or be under review for any journals or other conferences. A declaration should also be sent along with the paper stating that the paper is original and has not been submitted previously anywhere or published before.
- A maximum of two authors can present one paper but both have to register separately.
- Paper presenters who would like their papers to be published in a book with ISBN have to remit an additional fee of rupees 700/- if they need a copy per head.
- The edited paper should be submitted for publication on or before 30th Sep 2024
