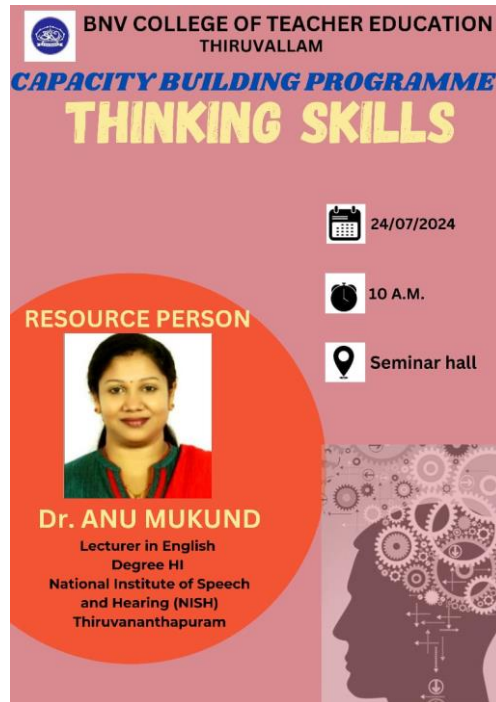


Capacity Building programme- 2024
